

The library is getting a makeover!



What does that mean?

The library will be closed **starting February 15th** for approximately 4-6 weeks so we can get new carpet, new walls, new doors, and a fresh new layout!

When will you reopen?

We hope to reopen around the middle of March, but we don't have an exact date yet. We will post notices online and on our outdoor sign once we know for sure.

Can I still check out books?

All of our books will be in storage, but you can still use your library card at any other Lakeland Library (including Dorr, Henika (Wayland), Leighton (Moline) & Salem). You can also use the Libby app to check out ebooks and audiobooks on your mobile device. If you don't have Libby or don't know how to use it, we'll be happy to help you set it up.

Can I still put books on hold?

You can put books on hold from other Lakeland libraries, to pick up at other Lakeland libraries while we're closed. Because of the way MeL works, you won't be able to check out MeL books during that time.



I checked out a book, and now you're closed! What do I do with it?

There's a few things you can do if you have a Hopkins book during the closure.

- 1) Hold on to it, and return it when we reopen. You won't be charged late fees.
- 2) Return it to a different Lakeland Library (Salem, Dorr, Wayland, Leighton), and it will be delivered back to us.

If it's a book from a different library (MeLCat, Interlibrary Loan), return it to a different Lakeland library so you won't get charged late fees.
